### **Footnote.**

In the 1941-1945 part of World War 2 my parents, Peggy and Bill Thurston, lived not far from Christchurch in Lincoln, where Dad was researching grass and barley improvement as his part of the War Effort. Because his work took Dad away from home for long periods of time, Mum was encouraged to take up golf to fill in her time.

50 years later Dad, always an honorable man, was finally able to break the confidentiality agreement he had signed in 1941, he admitted he had been in the Secret Service during the war. His role was to use his knowledge of grasses to create and camouflage the numerous airstrips which were needed to protect the mid-Canterbury/West Coast region. Ironically, golf courses with their long fairways were acquisitioned for his work and labour supplied by the members of the golf clubs who, at that time, were mostly women because the men were overseas. Dad was also proud of his authority to second whichever men were left to do the really physical work. He said it was always good to have a cold beer at the local pub with these chap.

This salver was given to my parents for their 25th Wedding Anniversary in 1964 from their friends Janet and Graham. Graham was in Dad's war team and it was Janet who introduced Mum to the game of golf.

It seems appropriate the salver be used as the for the Akarana Women's Anzac Trophy.
