CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Open to both Men and Women.
2. Every competitor must be a full playing member of an New Zealand affiliated Golf Club.
3. The entry fee of \$100.00 must be paid to confirm your entry. Includes a sprig lunch for players playing on Sunday. Account to direct credit entry fee:

4. Entries close at 5:00pm on Friday 27th July 2018 and the draw will be notified by email and posted on the Club's website - www.cambridgegolf.co.nz
5. Competitors must be ready to start at the appointed time.
6. The Rules of Play shall be those of the Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews except as varied by the local rules of the Cambridge Golf Club and as displayed on the Local Rules Board.
7. The decision of the Committee on any matters shall be final. Any protest must be lodged with the Committee within 15 minutes of the round in which the dispute has arisen.
8. There will be 18 holes played each day on Friday and Saturday and the field will be cut to 60 players plus ties for two rounds on Sunday. The committee has the right to select less than 60 players or to extend the field if it deems necessary to ensure that both the Men's and the Women's fields are appropriately provided for.
9. The Committee reserves the right to alter the programme at any time.
10. No refunds will be given for withdrawals after Friday 27th July unless a medical certificate is provided.
11. Competitors may win one prize only, except when they also have the lowest 18 hole Gross score for the Tournament.
12. In the event of a tie for first place in either division at the completion of the stipulated rounds, and light permits, a playoff will be held, otherwise those tied will be declared joint winners of the Cambridge Classic.
13. Ties for positions other than first place will be decided by the count back calculations in the DotGolf scoring system.
14. Motorised Golf Carts are prohibited unless a current medical certificate has been sighted and permission has been granted by the Tournament Director.
15. The organisers reserve the right to enter players by invitation at their discretion
16. GPS or rangefinders permitted for distance only The use by competitors of smart phones, cell phones or other electronic communication devices on the course is prohibited.
17. There will be Course Marshalls out on the course each day. They will be checking on slow play and adherence of rules. The Committee, at its sole discretion, reserves the right to apply a penalty for not complying with a reasonable request of a Course Marshall.
