



PACE OF PLAY POLICY HAMILTON GOLF CLUB

The following requirements to apply to all players at Hamilton Golf Club.

- **Ready Golf for all Club Scrambles and Stroke Play events.**
- **Playing groups should maintain contact with the group immediately in front of them.**
- **Where a group falls a hole behind and fails to catch up by the next hole, they must call through the following group if they are waiting to hit up.**
- **It is the responsibility of all the group members to maintain the required pace of play.**
- **All club members have the right to ask a group that has fallen behind to pick up the pace of play or allow the following group to play through.**

Any club member, who has formally asked a group to pick up the pace of play, shall be entitled to notify the Manager of their actions and shall name the members of that group. Group members will be notified and given the opportunity to explain their pace of play.

The Manager shall keep a record of those members who have been the subject of a slow play warning and have not supplied a satisfactory explanation. A warning issued to a member shall have a life of three months.

Where a member has been the subject of two slow play warnings within one month, he/she shall receive a written warning from the Manager, outlining the occasions of slow play and informing them that a subsequent offence within the next month will result in them being placed at the rear of the field.

Our policy is in no way meant to alienate and/or make one feel inferior. This is merely an attempt to ensure that everyone has an enjoyable game of golf.
