DISC DRAW

All members have numerical Disc's, and lists provide the key to the numbers.

1. Alphabetical order will show Disc No.
2. Disc number order will show the Member's Name & handicap.
3. Discs must be lodged at least **15 minutes** before start time.

The Women's Disc Draw is incorporated into the Men's Draw with allocated tees on Sundays.

Members not entering the competition on a Sunday morning will have no playing rights until after 12.30pm.

NEW MEMBERS

Responsibilities of the Proposer and Seconder

1. To ensure the **New Member** is introduced to other members.
2. To advise the **New Member** of the rules governing the conduct of the club.
3. Above all to ensure the **New Member** has sufficient knowledge of the Rules of Golf to be competent to perform the duty of marker to a fellow competitor. Please play with your nominee until they are so equipped.
4. New Members are unable to enter club competitions until an official NZGA Handicap has been obtained. However, they are welcome to play with the other Disc Draw players.

INSTRUCTIONS TO MEMBERS

1. The lowest handicap player in the four is responsible for course etiquette.
2. No one should move, talk or stand close to or directly behind the ball or the hole when a player is addressing the ball or making a stroke.
3. The player who has the honour should be allowed to play before an opponent or fellow competitor tees their ball.
4. No player should play until the players in front are out of range.
5. In the interest of all, players should play without delay. Players who **lose a clear hole** on the rest of the field **must** call following players through.
6. Players searching for a ball **must** allow other players coming up to pass them immediately the search is commenced. They should signal to the players following them to pass and should not continue their play until those players have passed and are out of range.
7. Before leaving a bunker, a player **must** fill up any holes they have made and rake the surface smooth.
8. A player **must** ensure any turf cut or displaced is replaced at once and pressed down; and that any damage to the putting green made by the ball or the player **is repaired**.
9. Care must be taken in removing the flagstick to ensure the green is not damaged. When attended, the flagstick should be held at arm's length. The flagstick must be properly replaced in the hole before the players leave the green.
10. When play of a hole has been completed players must immediately leave the putting green. Cards are not to be marked on the green.

11. Players **must not** practice pitch shots to any green or putt on them or use tees to practice. Two practice putting greens, a practice chipping green and driving nets are available.
12. Lost property and clubs found on the course are to be handed into the Match Committee or the Shop.
13. Members identity tags should be prominently displayed **on their bag.**
14. Children **are not permitted** on the course unless playing golf or acting as caddies. They **must** be supervised.
15. Members are expected to accept local rules and house regulations laid down by their committee in the interests of good order.
16. During competition times, members with visitors should report to a match committee member for allocation of a starting tee.
17. Any queries regarding etiquette or rules of golf are to be referred to the Match Committee immediately after the relevant round has been completed, except where the rules of golf require otherwise.
18. Keep trundlers at least three metres from edges of greens and off the tees
19. Behaviour on the Course: Throwing of clubs or the use of bad language on the course is a serious offence **and will not be tolerated.** The Executive committee can invoke suspension for serious or repeated incidents.
20. Animals **are not** permitted on the golf course or in the Café/Bar area unless a service animal.

CLUBHOUSE RULES

These rules apply to both Members and Visitors

Dress: A clean and neat standard of dress is required at all times both on the course and in the clubhouse. The following are not permitted: beachwear, short shorts, work jeans and bare feet.

Visitors: Visitors to the clubhouse should normally be restricted to one per member and it is that member's responsibility to introduce the visitor to a Committee member and ensure that the Visitor's book is signed.

Children: Children are permitted in the lounge area under the supervision of a parent or guardian and on special occasions as authorised by the committee. Parents/Guardians are responsible for the behaviour of their children at all times within the environments of the club.

Membership Cards: Current cards must be carried at all times. You may be asked to produce this.

Food in the Dining Room: Only meals supplied by the caterer will be permitted to be eaten in the Clubhouse, when they are in attendance.

Offensive Language: Will not be tolerated in the Clubhouse. The Executive Committee will ask offenders to leave. Repeated incidents could lead to a suspension of Membership.

HANDICAPPING

Golf New Zealand uses the World Handicap System.

Players are expected to act with integrity by following the Rules of Handicapping, attempt to make the best score possible at each hole, submit acceptable scores for handicap purposes as soon as possible on the day of play after the round, submit acceptable scores to provide reasonable evidence of their demonstrated ability, play by the Rules of Golf and certify the scores of fellow players.

A score may only be used for handicap purposes if, among other things, the round has been played over at least the minimum number of holes required for either a 9-hole or 18-hole score, IE:

- At least 10 holes played, the score is eligible for entry as an 18-hole score
- At least 9 holes played, the score is eligible for entry as a 9-hole score

It is a player's responsibility to ensure that, prior to playing a round in an authorised format of play, they know their current Handicap Index.

Eligibility for Club Competitions

To be eligible to enter Club competitions, members must hold a Handicap Index.

CONDITIONS OF PLAY

The Match Committee reserves the right to alter specified dates, events, entry fees, conditions of play and to postpone any round in any event.

Disc Draws

- Pay your entry fee in the Shop before play commences. **Entry not paid on the day**, then round is invalid.
- When printing your card using the Dot Golf kiosk, ensure you enter the day's competition.

NOTE: Pairs Competitions

Own Partner - you decide your partner and enter as a pair.
Drawn Partners - players enter with partners drawn by the organisers, normally after the event.

COMMON CAUSES OF SLOW PLAY

1. **Not being ready** - Select your club while others are playing.
2. **Delays on Tee & Green** - Mark your card while waiting your turn on the tee.
3. **Waiting while others play** - Walk directly to your ball or level with it, and get ready to play.
4. **Attending the Flag** - Nearest to the Pin attend the Flag, then pass it on.
5. **Equipment in front of Green** - Always place your equipment to the side nearest the approach to the next tee.

Juniors (under 18 years) - Are not eligible to play in the Nottingham Cup & Camjo Cup.

MATCH PLAY EVENTS

Entries

Ensure you are available to play all rounds set down for the event before you enter. Defaults are NOT acceptable – the defaulter may be penalised by not being eligible for the next match play event.

Any members who have not paid their entry fee by the closing date **will not** be entered in the Draw.

Draws

When a Draw has been made for a competition, players can ring the Club the day before for their starting times.

When times and starting tees have been allocated by the Match Committee, Rule 6-3 will apply to those players late on the tee.

a) **Individual Match** - Player disqualified.

b) **4BBB** - Match continues as long as one Partner is present at stipulated starting time. Late Player may join the match at the start of any hole on arrival Rule 30-3a.

Competitors in **Match Play** tournaments are not eligible to enter any competition other than the Hole-in-Two.

Match Play rounds must be played on the date set down, and can only be varied under special circumstances, by mutual agreement, and with the **approval** of the Club Captain or Women's Captain and the Match Committee.

HOLE IN ONE RULES

The allowance for 2021 is \$200

Members are charged an annual insurance fee, which is added to the annual subscription. An allowance set down by the Executive Committee which covers members for any Hole in One, so that the player may "shout" in the 19th.

Conditions

Full allowance if on Judgeford Golf Club's course; or if the player is representing Judgeford in Interclub; or an organised away game with another Club.

Half allowance if playing away from Judgeford, except as above.

The player must present a completed card, signed by their playing partner, for the round, within one month.

Please ensure you return the ball used, so we can get it mounted to record the event for the player.

Late on the Tee means Loss of Match.

LOCAL RULES

To be read in conjunction with the Rules of Golf and any additional Local Rules as displayed on the board outside between the locker rooms.

1. Out of Bounds

All golf course boundary fences. A ball crossing SH58 and coming to rest on the opposite side of the road. All other areas defined by white stakes and lines, including the flat square marker next to the first tee.

2. Penalty Areas

All areas of the course marked with red stakes or red lines.

3. Lifting Without Penalty

A ball lying outside a penalty Area **MAY** be lifted, cleaned and dropped within one club length of the reference point of complete relief if a ball lies in or on:

- a) embedded stones;
- b) a cut drain,
- c) wheel tracks,
- d) an abnormal course condition (animal holes, immovable obstructions or temporary water).

A ball lying outside a penalty area **MUST** be lifted, and dropped within one club length of the reference point of complete relief if a ball lies:

- a) in ground under repair;
- b) near a staked tree or tree under two club lengths in height that interferes with stance or area of intended swing;
- c) in a formed garden.

4. Immovable Obstructions

Relief under Rule 16 and includes; man-made paths, penalty area stakes, toilets, shelter fences, fixed sprinkler heads and irrigation control stations, small manuka posts and ropes around paths and/or greens.

5. Placing

When permitted, the ball's position must be marked. When lifted, the ball may be cleaned and placed by hand, once only, within 15cm, not nearer the hole on the fairway of the hole being played.

6. Lift, Clean & Drop

When this is permitted, the position of the ball must be marked. The ball must be dropped from knee height, as close as possible to the marker and not nearer the hole. Cleaning of the ball is permitted.

7. Local rule. alternative available to stroke & distance penalty for ball lost or out of bounds.

When a player's ball has not been found, or is believed to be out of bounds, the player may proceed with a two-stroke penalty under this local rule rather than proceeding under penalty of stroke and distance. Refer Local Rules Board

8. Competition Cards

Competition cards not signed by the player or where a score on a hole is lower than the actual score will result in disqualification. Note cards are deemed returned correctly when in the hands of the Committee (Match, score card box or Shop within the competition time frame). Exception is where player has not had the opportunity to check, or sign or return the card themselves.

9. Match Play Conditions

If the match is all square after 18 holes, use handicap strokes to continue until a hole is won. Play to be continued from original starting tee.

10. Motorised Carts

A current Medical Certificate is required for Major Competitions (see page 16) and Club Championships. Members are permitted to use carts without a Medical Certificate during the club disc draws, except if a major competition.

All new work on course to be treated as G.U.R.

Please repair all pitch marks and divots.

COMPETITION FORMATS

Foursomes:

Two players play as partners and use one ball. Partners strike alternately from the tee and thereafter play alternate shots until hole is completed. Scoring is done as for a Stroke round and half the partners combined handicap is applied.

Mixed Foursomes:

As above, except that the Women hit from their own tees. The Committee should lay down as a condition of play, whether the male or female play from the 1st tee.

Canadian Foursomes:

Played as above, except that both players play tee shots at each hole and then select which ball to continue the hole with. The ball selected is then played by the player whose ball is picked up. Alternate shots with the selected ball until the hole is complete.

Greensome (American) Foursomes:

Both players play tee shots at each hole, then play a second stroke with their partners ball. One ball is then selected and play proceeds as in the Foursomes. The owner of the ball selected plays the third shot (the player who hit the original tee shot with that ball).

South African Medal:

Two players play as partners and on completion of each hole, their **net** scores are multiplied to give their score for the hole. IE: *Andrew* has a **Net 4** and *Brian* has a **Net 6**, their score for the hole is **4 x 6 =24**.

Pairs Ambrose:

Two players play as partners. Both tee off and then select which ball is best situated. Both then play their second shots from this selected position. This process is continued until the hole is completed. This is a medal round with half the partners combined handicap being applied.

Bisque Par

In a regular par competition a player receives a win (+) where his Net score on a hole is under par, a half (o) if it equals par and a loss (-) when it exceeds par. The difference in a **Bisque Par** is that you elect to use your handicap strokes when you want them, rather than as indicated on the card. You **must tell your marker** whether or not you are taking a stroke on the hole played **before you tee off** the next hole.

Flag Tournament

This is a Medal competition and is scored in the normal way. However, in addition once a player has completed the number of strokes equal to par plus their handicap, they place a flag, with their name on it on the spot where their last shot came to rest. The objective being is to get as far round the course as possible with the strokes available and normally this will take some players past the 19th and 20th holes. For convenience we have players collect their **Flag** only as they commence the 19th hole.

Ringers Competition

Competitors play over a number of rounds, (in our case most of the season) and the eclectic score is the lowest score obtained on each hole over the period of play.

Medalford

A combination Net and Stableford round. Deduct your stableford from your net score to give your result.

For example: Net 70 less 36 Stableford points = 34.

Russian Stableford

Drawn Partners Stableford. Multiply each players stableford points at the end of the hole

For example: **1 x 3 = 3** or **2 x 3 = 6** or **3 x 0 = 0**.

Irish Stableford: In the 18-hole version of the competition the normal stableford score counts for holes 1 to 6. The stableford score for the holes 7 to 12 are multiplied by 2 and the stableford score for holes 13 to 18 multiplied by 3.

Playing Handicap when Multiple Tees with Different Pars Are Used in a Competition (Mixed Events)

When a competition is played from two or more sets of tees (such as mixed gender or mixed ability events), depending on the format of play and any difference in par between tees, additional strokes may need to be added to the standard calculation of the Playing Handicap for equity purposes and to determine finishing positions, results and prizes.

(i) Stroke Play and Match Play formats (where results are recorded as gross or net scores)

A player competing from a set of tees with a higher par must receive additional strokes for the round, equal to the difference between the par of the tees they are playing and the tees with the lowest par.

(ii) Stroke and Match Play formats (where results are recorded relative to par)

No additional strokes are added to the standard calculation of the Playing Handicap when the par is different between tees.

(iii) Stableford formats

No additional strokes are applied to the standard calculation of the Playing Handicap when the par is different between tees.

(iv) Par/Bogey formats

No additional strokes are applied to the standard calculation of the Playing Handicap when the par is different between tees.

Application of Playing Handicap in Mixed Competitions

The men's Blue and White courses are both par 71 and the women's Yellow course is par 72. Therefore, if playing the Stroke or Match Play format under clause (i) the women add 1 additional stroke to their Course Handicaps.

If playing under the formats (ii), (iii) and (iv) no players add additional strokes to their Playing Handicaps.

SHOOTOUT RULES

John & Joan Hetherington Memorial Trophy

1. The qualifying rounds for the Shootout are the 10 Monthly Medals listed for Men and 10 LGU rounds listed for Women. The dates for 2021 are on the previous page.
2. The best 4 Net scores are added to give an overall 4 round total. The top 10 players with the best combined Net scores will contest the Shootout.
3. If there is a tie or ties for the last qualifying position(s) a **Chip/Pitch-Off** will be used to break the tie(s). The person(s) furthest away from the hole, no matter where they land and finish, after the Chip/Pitch-Off is eliminated.
4. Once the Shootout commences, one player is eliminated after every hole. There are two ways to be eliminated:
 - 4.1. The player who shoots the highest Net score on the hole is eliminated.
 - 4.2. If two or more players tie for the highest Net score on the hole, before moving to the next tee, those players have a **Shootout** or **Chip-Off**. The person furthest away from the hole no matter where they land and finish after the Chip-Off is eliminated.
5. Play continues in this manner until only one player is left. The final player left is the Winner.
