

WOMEN'S CLUB DAY

Women's club day is played on Saturdays, between early February and November when, for an annual Competition fee of \$25, you may play in the competitions as detailed in the fixtures book. Details of all competition formats are on this website or can be found in the back of the Weekend Women's folder which is kept in our Locker room.

New members may, if they wish, pay their \$25 any time during the year. They will be advised if they have missed some of the competitions.

All trophies and prizes are presented at Prize giving which is held after Women's Closing Day. Please see fixtures book for the date.

Saturday Tee times are from 9 am. You must be a full playing member to play in this time.

To play in the Women's Saturday Tee times please put your name down on the start sheet in the first available space from 9am, no later than the Wednesday mid-day prior to the Saturday.

(Please note that this may not be the time you will play)

The office will re do the draw on Fridays depending on the competition/s for the Saturday. You will receive an email after the draw has been redone, to advise you of your new tee time, if it has been changed. We vary the draw so that we play with different people each week. Please arrive 20 minutes before your tee time to confirm your arrival and to print out your card. If you are unable to make your tee time **PLEASE** phone the office as soon as possible so that we can adjust the draw early. Please note that if a number of players pull out due to wet weather, your tee time will be moved up to fill the empty spaces, so please allow for this. If you do not have your name down to play when draw is done, then find you are able to play, please phone the office and you will be slotted into the draw.

You may play before 9am or between 9.50am and Mid-day.

On a Saturday you may enter the following **Scramble Competitions** if a scramble is being held, without having paid the \$25 competition fee. A fee of \$3.00 would be paid at the office before you play your round of golf. The scramble can be entered into up until Mid-day on a Saturday if you are a Full Playing Member. You must have another player record your score and sign your card.

After play, your card needs to be scanned and then handed into the office so that the following can be recorded in our Women's folder: Stableford points, pars, birdies, holes in two.

(Recording will be done on a Sunday.) Birdies will need to be recorded by the player on the Birdie Tree in the Women's locker room.

Please note this new system will be on trial for one year.

The results for the scramble competitions will be finalized at the end of the year on a date decided by the Women's committee.
