

BARRETT WALKER TROPHY

This Trophy was presented by Marie and Stan Walker. Marie Barrett was one of the early Redwood Park Members and was the Secretary of the Women's Committee for one year. She played golf regularly and introduced a potty and a magnum of champagne for the runner up to the Club Champion. She was a life member.

Stan Walker, known as a grand old gentleman started playing golf aged seventy. He lived in Ranui and was frequently on the golf course. He followed and supported Women's golf. He had a heart attack during the prize giving of the Fairday Poultry Tournament in 1982. Although he was revived he died within the fortnight.
