

## 2021 SCRAMBLE COMPETITIONS

You may enter the following Scramble competitions on the selected Saturdays by paying the daily scramble fee of \$3.00 before you play. (During 2021 you do not have to have paid the \$25 competition fee to participate in the following competitions.)

### **BIRDIE TREE:-**

You may only compete on a Saturday. Open to all handicaps from Opening Day through to a day as determined by the Women's Committee. When a "Birdie" is achieved on any hole the player enters their name on the appropriate place on the Birdie Tree.

Winner will be the player who has recorded the most "Birdies" during the season from Opening Day through to a day as determined by the Women's Committee.

### **ECLECTICS:-**

You may only compete on a Saturday. (For 18 holes). Open to all handicaps from Opening Day through to a day as determined by the Women's Committee. The best score on each hole over the year will be kept.

(Please note the eclectic scores are not used for this competition when other players are involved in Matchplay.)

### **"PAR" TREE:-**

You may only compete on a Saturday. Open to all players with a handicap of 0-20 from Opening Day through to a day as determined by the Women's Committee.

When a "Par" is scored on any hole the total number of pars is recorded on the appropriate sheet in our Weekend Women's results folder.

Winner will be the player who has recorded most "Par's" during the season from Opening Day through Closing Day.

### **"PAR" CEL:-**

You may only compete on a Saturday. Open to all players with a handicap of 21-36 from Opening Day through to a day as determined by the Women's Committee.

When a "Par" is scored on any hole the total number of pars is recorded on the appropriate sheet in our Weekend Women's results folder.

Winner will be the player who has recorded most "Par's" during the season from Opening Day through to a day as determined by the Women's Committee.

### **"PAR" TY:-**

You may only compete a Saturday. Open to all players with a handicap of 37-54 from Opening Day through to a day as determined by the Women's Committee..

When a "Par" is scored on any hole the total number of pars is recorded on the appropriate sheet in our Weekend Women's results folder.

Winner will be the player who has recorded the most "Par's" during the season from Opening Day through to a day as determined by the Women's Committee.

### **HOLES IN TWO:-**

Weekend Women can enter for Holes in two on our competition day provided they have paid the scramble fee before playing from Opening Day through to a day as determined by the Women's Committee.

(Please note the final date for the above competitions will be approximately 3 weeks before Prize-giving at the end of the year.)

### **FURTHER INFORMATION**

On a Saturday you may enter the following **Scramble Competitions** without having paid the \$25 competition fee. A fee of \$3.00 has to be paid at the office before you play your round of golf. The scramble can be entered into up until Mid-day on a Saturday if you are a Full Playing Member. You must have another player record your score and sign your card.

After play, your card needs to be scanned and then handed into the office so that the following can be recorded in our Women's folder: Stableford points, pars, birdies, holes in two.

(Recording will be done on a Sunday.) Birdies will need to be recorded by the player on the Birdie Tree in the Women's locker room.

Please note this new system will be on trial for one year.

The results for the scramble competitions will be finalized at the end of the year on a date decided by the Women's committee.

HOLES IN TWO

“PAR”TREE (Course Handicaps 0-20)

“PAR”CEL (Course Handicaps 21-36)

“PAR”TY (Course Handicaps 37-54)

The **Scramble Competition** is based on Stableford points. The winner gets 3 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> gets 2 points and 3<sup>rd</sup> gets 1 point. The points are recorded during the season and they accumulate. The prize money is then shared out amongst the participants. Some of the scramble money will also be used for the winners of the other scramble competitions.

(Please note we do not currently run a Weekday Women’s group.)
