

## **South Head Golf Club Inc. Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> August 2020**

### Operational Rules for South Head Golf Course under Covid-19 Level 3

- Play is only for those alone or with players from their own “bubble”
- At Alert Level 3, the government has stipulated that you can only expand your bubble a small amount to bring in close family, isolated people or caregivers.
- The office will be open from 8am to 4pm but all interaction between players and club staff are to be contactless. There will be a screen in place for health reasons at the office reception.
- To assist with this requirement all tee times must be booked in advance via phone or online.
- No score cards will be issued or accepted by office staff
- Please adhere to tee times so as to avoid unnecessary gatherings of players. There will be a 6min gap between solo players and 10min gap between groups. Stick strictly to the “2 metre “rule.
- Players are to stay well clear of the tees or remain in the carpark until their allotted time for the same reason.
- All players must register (name, postal address and phone number & purpose for visit) for Contact Tracing purposes. This must be done by phone or Dot Golf App “Check-In” prior to arriving for play to avoid any group assembly at the office.
- There will be no “sales” from the office. The Clubhouse, changing rooms and toilets will be closed.
- The practice putting green will be closed.
- There is to be no sharing of equipment and no hire carts nor trundlers will be available.
- Use of own carts is permitted.
- All pins and bunker rakes have been removed. The hole will be located at approximately centre of the green.
- Drinking fountains, ball washers and course toilets will be unavailable for use.
- Any personal items brought onto the course must be taken away with you, including any rubbish.
- Darren and Lynn`s greenkeepers house is part of their “bubble” and will be roped off. Do not attempt to retrieve golf balls from within this area (note; sign on 14<sup>th</sup> tee).
- The ramp down to the practice green will be closed
- Access from the 11<sup>th</sup> green to the 12<sup>th</sup> tee is to be via the cart access track.
- There is to be no “call through” of players or groups to avoid unnecessary assembly
- Please spend minimum time on “lost” balls to assist with the flow of players.
