



Twilight Season (October 6th 2021 – March 9th 2022)

Rules of Competition

Competition

- The competition is a Team of 2 played over 9 Holes per round.
- The Competition varies each week with different playing format (e.g. Four Ball Best Ball, Foursomes, Combined Stableford, Russian Roulette).

Team Composition

- Can be 2 Ladies, 2 Men or Mixed. If your partner can't play you can team up with another person.
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Dates and Starting Times

- Every Wednesday from 6th October through to 9th March. A few weeks break for Festive seasons in December.
- Cards in by 5:15pm latest to Starter office. Shotgun start at 5:30pm.

Affiliated Players

- Women Handicap index = 0 to 40.5
- Men Handicap Index = 0 to 39.6

Non-Affiliated Players

- Non-Affiliated visitors are welcome to play. They won't be eligible in the Competition but are entitled for the weekly Spot prizes Draw.

Postponement & Abandonment

Only in very unusual circumstances will play be called off early in the day. Players should always assume that the round will be played and report on time for play. Only extreme wet weather condition should force an early postponement. In the event of a postponement after commencement of play, the Air Horn will be sounded continuously and a match official will convey the postponement to players on the course.

Rule of Play

The Rules of Play shall be the Rules of Golf as approved by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews and any Local Rules approved by the Omokoroa Golf Club Inc.

Disputes

Any disputes or protest must be lodged to the Twilight committee on the day in which the disputed matter has arisen. The Twilight committee will decide in full decisions on disputes and these matters shall be final.

Dress Standard

The Club expects a high standard of dress and behaviour by players both on the course and in the Clubhouse. Bare feet, jandals, work boots, singlets of any style and dirty and unkempt clothing are not acceptable. Footwear worn on the course is not to be worn in the Clubhouse. Long trousers and shorts must be of a tailored style rather than rugby or beach shorts style. Team uniforms are encouraged provided they meet the above criteria.

Prizes

- Weekly Prizes will be awarded.
- Accumulative points are 5 points for 1st place, 4 points for 2nd place, 3 points for 3rd prize, 2 points for 4th prize and 1 point for turning up for a team.
- Accumulative points for End of Season prizes. Prize pool over \$2000.

Additional

- Weekly Spot prizes draw. You need to be at the Club house for the draw.
- Weekly Raffles (Meat Pack)
- Weekly lucky draw from Caterer (shouting next meal for FREE)

Meals

Light meals will be available from the Club Café's after Twilight, and food and beverages will also be available prior to the commencement and after the round.
