

Youth Development Programme

The Board has approved this programme for 2016. The programme provides some financial support for our talented young players who wish to pursue an amateur career in golf. It is envisaged that these golfers will have graduated from the WPGC Junior development programme and are now the playing ambassadors for our club and the Auckland region.

There are limitations on the budget and any funding will be allocated on a case by case basis from time to time at the discretion of the General Manager of WPGC on behalf of the WPGC Match Committee.

An annual application must be made by each qualifying player to the General Manager for consideration. This application must be accompanied by a letter stating how the candidate has met the criteria and the financial support required from the Club.

Qualifying for Youth Development Programme and Club Expectations of Players

To qualify a player will meet the following requirements:

Will hold their primary membership at Whitford Park and give an undertaking that they will continue to do so in future.

Will pledge to retain their amateur status for the near future.

Will have represented WPGC at a senior level and have earned regional or national representation (or inclusion in development squads), or achieved notable tournament results.

Be aged between 17 to 25 years (exceptions may apply to outstanding Juniors).

Be a good ambassador for WPGC and a role model for golf generally.

Will make themselves available for WPGC Pennant Teams/ Games (unless selected for Regional / National Representation).

Be prepared to support WPGC by giving time to help out with big events and to help coach junior players from time to time.
